Snares: Snares play eighth-note patterns. Dynamic *p* is indicated.

Tenors: Tenors play eighth-note patterns. Dynamic *p* is indicated.

Basses: Basses play eighth-note patterns. Measure 158 has grace notes (3 groups of 3). Measures 159 and 160 have grace notes (3 groups of 6).

Cym: Cym is silent.
